The publication is trilingual, and articles can be submitted in Finnish, Swedish or English.

Please send an abstract of approximately 300 words by 31.5.2024 to Heidi Pitkänen (heidi.m.pitkanen[at]utu.fi). Acceptance decisions will be announced by 15.6. The deadline for submission of finished articles is 15.10.2024. After peer review and editorial work, Nautica Fennica will be published at the end of 2025.
